#### Directions from Holiday Inn to Circle K Farms

Travel south on route 40 until you come to route 92, about 13 miles. Turn right, traveling west on 92 for approximately 4-5 miles until you come to 400 East Street. Go left onto 400 East Street traveling south about 3 1/2 miles. Farm is on the right.

#### Directions to Circle K Farms from all points

From route 92 take 400 East Street and go south 3.5 miles and turn right onto farm lane (west side of road).

From the East – From interstate 80 travel 40 North to route 92 and follow directions above.

From the West – Take interstate 80 to route 78. Travel north on 78 to route 92 and follow directions to 400 East street

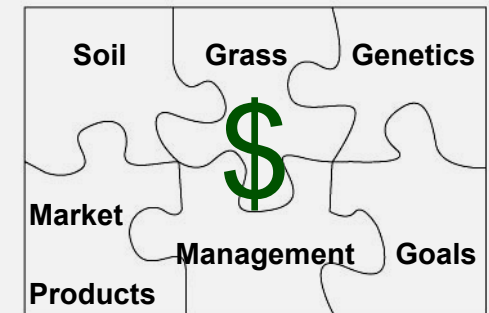
